

## Half cirkular shawl



Yarn: One skein unspun woll

Gauge: 13 sts to 4 inches



Needles: 5 or 6 mm, (US 9 or 10)

Cast on 85 sts, knit 6 rows.

\*Knit 5 sts, turn, yarn over, knit back.

Knit 5 sts, knit the yo together with the next stitch, knit 4 sts, turn, yo knit back.

Repeat and knit 5 more stitches before the turn ( the sts knitted together with the yo and 4 sts). The last turn there will be only 5 sts left on the needle. Turn, yo knit back.

Now turn before 5 sts **before** the last turning. (Knit from the long edge upp towards the neck and turn 5 sts before the last turn) The rows will be shorter and shorter. Turn, yo, knit back. Repeat. When there is just 5 sts left, knit the whole row and knit the yo together with the sts which is supposed to be knitted **after** the yo. (You will knit 5 sts, knit the yo together with the next sts, knit 4 sts, knit the yo together with the sts, knit 4 sts and so on)

PURL the next row down to the long edge.\*

Repeat from \* to \* 8 times and knit 6 rows. DO NOT cast of. Cast on 3 sts and knit an I-cord together with the long edge.

### I-cord:

Cast on 3 sts, knit 2 sts, knit the next sts together with one you pick up from the edge of the shawl. Knit 4 inches or more and check the tension of the I-cord. Cast of.

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
