

The Pasture - shawl in 1 ply wool from the forest sheep - Wermland sheep

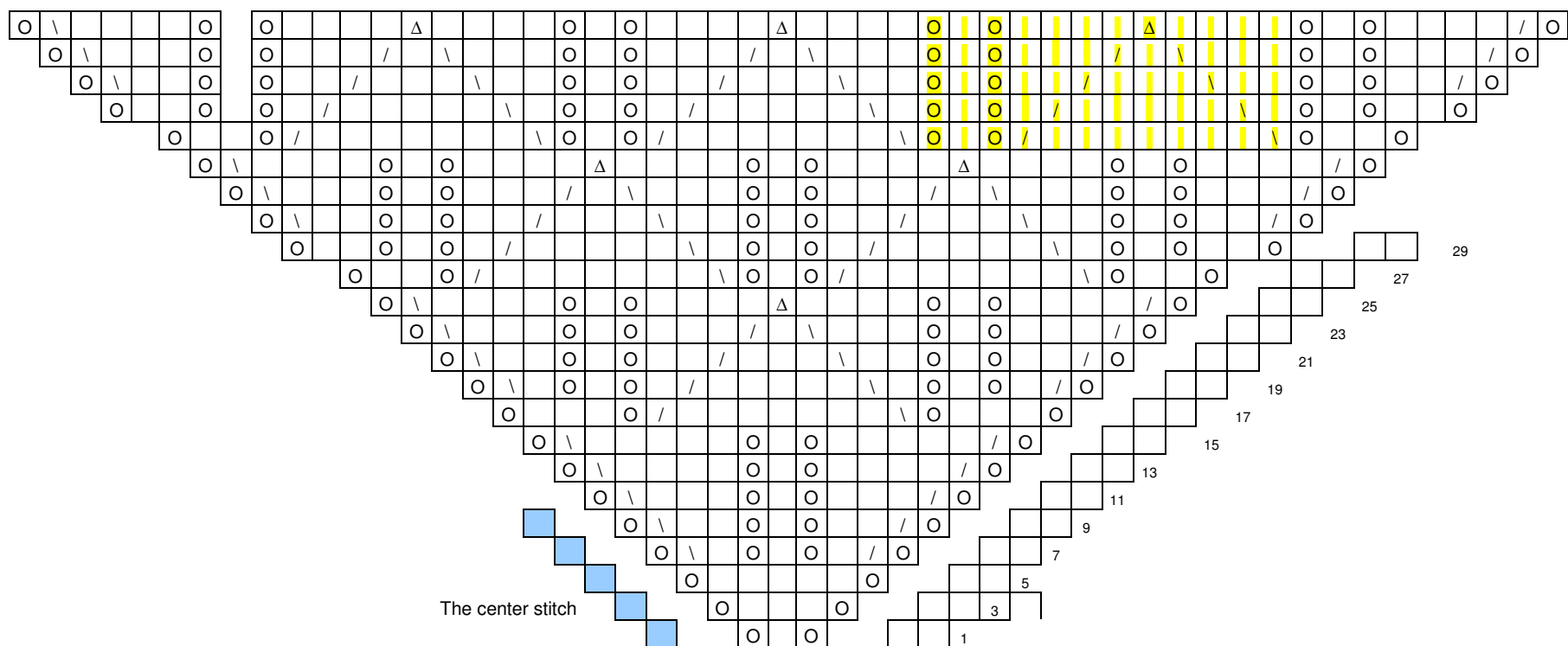
The shawl is knit from the neck and down. Cast on 2 stitches and knit 6 rows. You will have a tiny little piece with 2 stitches in the end. Pick up 3 stitches along the edge of the piece and pick up 2 more in the cast on. Now you will have 7 stitches on the needles.. Det blir en mycket liten rak bit med två maskor i ena änden.

The yarn is a single ply from forest sheep. The needles are 5 mm.



Start knitting from the chart on the next page. Read from right to left and from the bottom up. Start at the number 1 with 2 stitches at the edge. The chart shows half of the shawl and the stitches in the middle are marked with a light blue colour. For the other side of the shawl repeat knitting from the chart. The chart shows every second row. On the wrong side of the shawl you will knit 2 stitches in the beginning and end of the row and purl all the stitches and yarn over's in between.





The yellow marking is a pattern repeat, it is easy to just repeat this until the shawl has become the size you want it to be. Of course you will have to repeat the part of the chart that makes the increasing in the beginning and in the end. When the size is as you want it to be follow the chart on the next page.

□	Knit
○	Yarn over
/	Knit 2 together
\	Slip 1 stitch as if to knit , slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit them together though the back loop.
△	Slip one stitch, knit 2 together and pull the slipped stitch over the 2 you knit together

The chart shows that you continue with the yarn overs over the one you already have done and the △ continues over the ones you already have done from the first chart.

This chart also shows the rows from the right side. Knit the rows from the wrong side as you have done before, 2 knitted stitches in the beginning and the end of the row, everything else is purled. The 2 knitted stitches is not shown in the chart.

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Knit 2 - edge

Knit chart 2 for as long as you want to.
 Cast off by knitting 2 stitches, transfer them back to the left needle and knit them together through the back loops. Knit 1, transfer the 2 stitches back to the left needle and knit them together through the back loops. Repeat until there are no more stitches left, cut the yarn and pull the yarn through the loop. Weave in the ends after the shawl is blocked.
